

The Rosengart is a treasure trove of 19th & 20th Century masters. Its easy to spend hours with the 32 Picassos + 100 of his watercolors, drawings and sculpture. The Rosengart is a world-class collection of magnificent beauty.

As in all of Switzerland, Lucerne's museums are both welcoming and child friendly. Maybe it's the kid in me but, I always make time to explore The Museum of Transport. You'll find examples of every conceivable machine and conveyance for road, rail, water, air & space here. An eye opener for every age.

Travel into Switzerland should also be fun and that's why I rely on SWISS. My trip this time included a terrific R/T onboard one of their new 777-300 fleet. This new state-

SWISS 777's Business Class is as good as it gets. Cantonal menus are both seasonal and a delight to the palate. Yes, this can happen airborne. From the moment you board you'll enjoy the ride as few aircraft can equal the stability of this marvelous BIG-bird. Even light sleepers actually awake rested as

the newest massage seats convert instantly to truly comfortable beds extending well over two meters.

In every season, you experience a true taste of Switzerland where award winning chefs always prepare a variety of local specialties. This is not airline food folks. It's a real menu from appetizers, to main course, variety of cheeses, fresh fruits and always fun deserts + Swiss chocolates. In turn, their champagnes are first rate,

as are a revolving selection of provincial wines from France, Italy, Switzerland & Germany.

Less than 7 minute walk from Banhoff to des Balances. Check-in is a mere two minute affair. For me, next is always a shave + good hot shower followed by an alpine cold one. I usually head down to the bar as this family hotel insists your first drink is truly complementary and then, a fine Swiss lunch for me.

Culinary delights are a part of des Balances DNA. Meals matter and their marvelous kitchen is first-rate from breakfasts, lunches and of course, dinners. Here, the menus change monthly at the gifted hands of 14 Gault-Millau point award winning culinary artists, chefs Andy Fluri and Niko Eichner. They truly enchant your eyes and palate with incredible lunch and dinner specialties. And yes, you'd have to dine there for weeks to exhaust their variety. Dinners range from a la carte preferences to 5 and 7 course magnificent offerings. Perhaps a cozy table overlooking the river or, on the terrace in warm seasons?

My strong advice for breakfasts is, whenever possible, indulge with ample time. Their buffet is marvelously extensive, diverse







and entirely worth the pleasure. As always, their kitchen prepares superb omelettes to your preference. Guilty as charged, I am a bacon & eggs aficionado and here, they are divine! You'll find no better first meal yenue in Lucerne.

Every room guarantees the comforts any traveler might ever desire. Ample sitting and reading spaces, always a well prepared desk, beds that cater to a deep and restful sleep as you snuggle beneath their wonderful down comforters.
